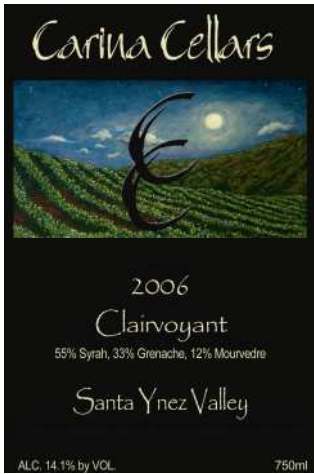
2006 Viognier Central Coast ~ With the perfect balance of weight and fruitiness this wine is sure to please the dedicated white drinker as well as the passionate red drinker. Tropical flavors abound with pineapple, grapefruit, pear and mango finishing with the slight floral twist expected in a true Viognier.

2004 Syrah, Santa Barbara County ~ A blend of Syrah from premier vineyards in Santa Barbara County, this wine offers a smooth and rich palate, touched with blackberries and spice, and a slightly smoky finish. 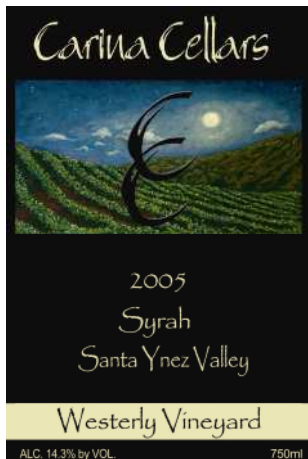

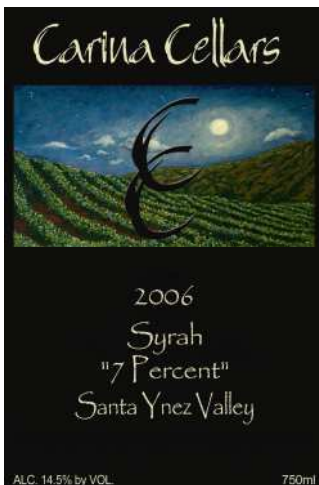


2006 Clairvoyant 55% Syrah, 33% Grenache, 12% Mourvedre
~ Like a stroll through fields of strawberries and boysenberries, this blend brings the classic notes of Chateauneuf du Pape to the rich terroir of the central coast. With hints of violets and sage, and nuances of pomegranate and toffee, it is the perfect match for roast pork or pasta Bolognese. With a finish as long and lush as a chocolate souffle this wine can be enjoyed now or allowed to age for 5-7 years.

2005 Syrah, Westerly Vineyard ~ Instantly fresh and tart, like a homemade berry pie on a summer day, this wine is reminiscent of warm breezes and intoxicating aromas. With an essence of pomegranate that will stain your hands and a mouthfeel bursting with cranberries, blueberries, and raspberries there are plenty of bright fruits to please the senses. A touch of nutmeg on the nose balances the crisp acidity that is characteristic of Westerly Vineyard while a soft structure complements the subtle tannins. Pair with seared duck breast and a classic spring salad for a winning combination of sweet and savory. This wine will age nicely for the next 4-6 years. *350 Cases Produced*



2006 "7 Percent" 93% Syrah, Colson Canyon Vineyard, 7% Viognier, Stolpman Vineyard

Modeled after the classic Cote-Rotie style blend of the northern Rhone, this wine combines the bold intensity of a warm climate Syrah with the complex elegance of Viognier. The hint of violet and cherry blossom is augmented with the deep, rich tones of blackberry, clove, and pomegranate, making this the ideal wine for a night of romance and candlelight.
