Although this wine takes its name from the French word *Clairvoyance*, meaning to “see clearly” into the future, one need not possess extra-sensory perception to enjoy this magnificent southern Rhone-style blend!

Allow your senses to come alive as your eyes gaze at the rich burgundy color, and your nose is enticed with pomegranates, acai, jasmine, and coffee. Your palate awakens to medley of cranberries, dates and plums that finishes with a hint of black pepper.
